## **MONDAY, APRIL 29<sup>th</sup>:**

7:30 a.m.: Leave Durham and travel by bus from Durham to Birmingham, AL. During trip there will be a talk giving the overview background of the Civil Rights Movement of the 1960s as well as video presentations.

5 p.m.: arrive Birmingham, Check into Drury Inn, 160 State Farm, Birmingham, AL

6 p.m.: Dinner at Jim N' Nick's Bar B-Q Restaurant, 220 Oxmoor Road, Birmingham, 35209.

## **TUESDAY, APRIL 30<sup>th</sup>:**

8:45 a.m.: leave hotel - Tour Kelly Ingram Park, 16<sup>th</sup> Street/5th Avenue N.

10 – 11: Tour 16th Street Baptist Church, 1530 6<sup>th</sup> Ave, N, Birmingham 35203.

11-12:30: Tour Birmingham Civil Rights Institute, 520 16<sup>th</sup> Street, N, Birmingham, 35203.

10:30 a.m.: stop at Coretta Scott King's childhood home, where she & Dr. King married.

11:15 - 12:15: drive to Marion; view where incident with Jimmy Lee Jackson occurred; drive past his grave on way to Selma

12:30 p.m.: lunch in Selma at Lannie's , 205 Medical Center Pkwy, Selma, AL 36701

1:30 - 2: driving tour of Selma (Brown's Chapel, 410 Martin Luther King St, Selma etc.)

2 - 3:15: walk across Edmund Pettis Bridge, US 80, Business. Visit Voting Rights Museum, 6 US Highway East, Selma, on other side of bridge.

3:15 - 5:45: Drive through Lowndes County to Montgomery along route of the March (Rt. 80), explaining about Lowndes County on the way. Stop at Lowndes County Interpretive Center, 7002 US-80, Hayneville, 36040

5:45 p.m.: check into Embassy Suites Hotel, 300 Tallapoosa Street, Montgomery. Evening on your own - will provide list of nearby restaurants
